JUST JESUS:

Just like the Galatians, sometimes we get tricked and fooled into believing that we need more than Just Jesus to be free from sin and have eternal life. Spend some time this week reading and praying through the following verses to remind you that God's gift of freedom really is Just Jesus.

- 1. **John 3:16** "Thank you God that you loved me so much that You sent Your one and only Son, so that when I believe in Him, I won't perish, but I'll have eternal life."
- 2. **Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:9** "God, I know I don't always do the right thing, but I thank you that when I tell you about the wrong things I do, You are faithful and just and will forgive me."
- 3. **Romans 10:9** "Thank you God that when I confess with my mouth that Jesus is Lord and when I believe in my heart that You raised Jesus from the dead, I am saved and I have freedom from sin."
- 4. **Ephesians 2:8** "Thank you Lord that I don't have to earn my freedom by doing all the right things or acting the right way. Thank you that my freedom is a gift from you."
- 5. **Romans 5:8** "Thank you Jesus for paying the price for my sin by dying on the cross."
