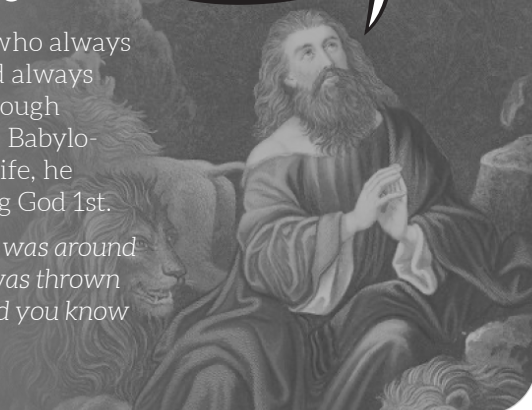

# Did You See This?
