But we give tithes and offerings to show God that He's more important than what we can buy here on this earth.

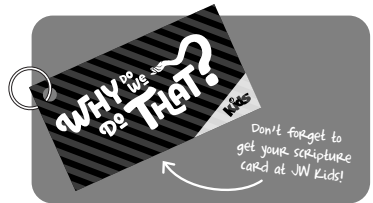
God doesn't deserve our leftovers; He deserves the first and best of what we can give Him.

Try practicing tithing in these simple fun ways this week!



1. Grab 10 one dollar bills. Cold hard cash. Decide to which charity the \$1 goes.
2. Cut a pizza into 10 slices. Place 1 on a plate. Then as a family decide what to do with it.
3. Gather 170 pennies. One for each hour of the week. Take out 17 of those. This is a good illustration of how much of our time should be given back to God in one capacity or another.
4. Get 10 flowers for the house. 9 of one color and 1 of another. Arrange them together and put the single color in the middle. That single flower stands out! Our giving to God should stand out in our hearts as well.
