O =

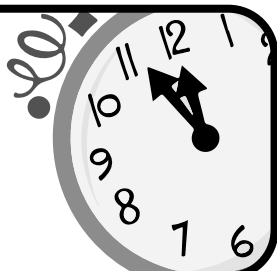
P =

When do you plan to rest AND spend time with God this week?

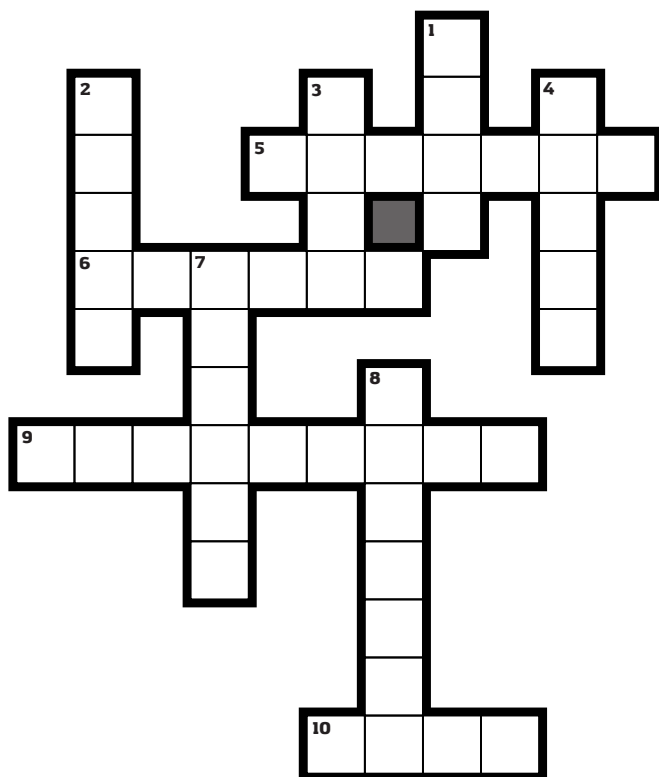
STOP 'N' TRY
