S means Surrender

Letting go of our lives, giving our life to God.

R means Remember

Remember all the awesome God moments.

D means Deliver

When we tell our story, we can't control the outcome of what happens after that.

P means Power

Allow God to do the rest of the work. He knows what will happen as a result of your story.
