Did you know there is nothing about us that God doesn't know or can't see? He knows our thoughts, our actions, what we ate for breakfast. He even knows what's in our hearts. This verse reminds us that God's word, the Bible, is active – it's powerful. When we read God's word, it helps us see what things we have in our hearts, like what attitudes, actions and thoughts we have, that are like Jesus and what ones are not.

Take a minute and do a heart check with God – ask Him if there's anything there that shouldn't be.
