

THIS MONTH


Hey guys, it's week #4 of Know and Become and this week we're continuing to learn What'S UP in the Bible by using the tool **Understand It! Woo Hoo.**

BUT WAIT!!! We're gunna change it up! Each day we are going to mark up our Bibles as we learn all of the amazing things that Jesus has to show us to Know and Become like Him. So, take a look at the key below because each question will have you do something a little bit different.

ASK YOURSELF

Who wrote these verses? Write their name next to the verses **Paul** ✓

What does this teach me about God? Draw A Box 

Does this teach me something about Jesus? Draw a Cross 

Does this teach me anything about myself? Underline it

Is God giving a Promise? **Highlight it**

Is there a praise?  Circle it

Is there a command to obey? Draw a 10 Commandments Symbol 

Is there a sin I need to stay away from? Draw an X 

Do I have any questions? Draw a question mark 

Each day read the verses listed and then go through the questions above to help you understand what they mean. Remember, you won't be able to answer every single question in each passage you read. But that's OK!

DAY 1

Proverbs 2:1-8

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: The Book of Proverbs was written by Solomon, the wisest man in history! After Jesus of course!

Proverbs is a collection of short sayings that help people live like Jesus.

DAY 2

Colossians 3:12-15

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: The book of Colossians talks A LOT about Jesus. His name is used in different ways 62 times! WOAH!

The Book of Colossians is a letter Paul wrote to the people of Colossae. Check out the map in your Bible and see if you can find Colossae.

DAY 3

Luke 6:46-49

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: The author Luke was actually a doctor! So one smart dude!

This story is a parable. A parable is a short story Jesus would use to teach people a lesson.

DAY 4

Psalms 23

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: "Psalm" actually means hymn or song, so the book of Psalms is a whole bunch of worship songs! Pretty cool!

This is a Psalm people would use to express trust in God because of how He always watches over us.

Bonus Challenge! Pray the Psalm by yourself or with your parents

DAYS

Matthew 22:36-40

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: The author Matthew was a tax collector before knowing and following Jesus.

These verses tell you the number #1 thing to remember about following Jesus. In these verses, Jesus is talking to the Pharisees and Sadducees which were the religious teachers of Jesus' time.
