We are in week two of our Easter series and this series is all about love lived out – specifically how Jesus showed

the ultimate act of love by dying on a cross for our sins. This week we are going to look at Jesus's journey from Palm Sunday all the way to Easter Sunday.

#### Day #1 Palm Sunday (Luke 19:28-40)

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: The Palm Leaf was a symbol of victory and peace. Usually to Honor a king

- Picture It: Read this story and imagine yourself being one
  of the townspeople when Jesus rode in. What do you think
  you would have done when you saw Jesus?
- · Answer It: What did the people shout when they saw Jesus?
- Live It Out: This story shows us how the people worshipped Jesus as a king. Spend some time today worshipping Jesus. You can worship by:
  - Playing your favorite worship song
  - Praying and talking to Jesus
  - Writing down all the things you can think of that describe who Jesus is (ex: He's our King, Savior, Protector...)



# Day #2 Jesus Heals the Leper (Matthew 8:1-4)

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: The name says it all. The Last Supper was Jesus' last meal with his twelve disciples before he died on the cross.

- Picture It: Read the story and picture yourself sitting next to Jesus during the last supper. What would that have been like?
- Answer It: What was Jesus celebrating with his disciples? (hint: read verse 18)
- Live it Out: During the supper that Jesus had with his friends, he told them to remember what he was going to do. Easter is a time to remember that Jesus died so that our sins could be forgiven. Spend some time talking to Jesus and thanking Him for what He did.



## Day #3 Jesus Washes His Disciples' Feet (John 13:1-17)

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: Feet washing is considered a symbol of servanthood


- Picture It: Read the story and picture yourself washing the feet of the disciples, like Jesus did. What would that have been like?
   Smelled like?
- Answer it: Before Jesus washed the disciples' feet, what were they arguing about?
- Live it Out: Jesus loved his friends by serving them and washing their feet. We can follow His example. Look for ways that you can serve the members of your family today. If you are willing to serve, you might find that you will end up changing the world!



## Day #4 Jesus Prays in the Garden (Matthew 26:36-46)

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: When Jesus prayed, he was so stressed he sweat blood! WOW!

- Picture it: Read the story and picture being in the garden with Jesus. Would you have fallen asleep? Would you have stayed up and prayed? How would you have felt when the soldiers came?
- Answer it: How many times did Jesus find the disciples sleeping?
- Live it Out: Jesus knew what was about to happen to Him, and He was greatly troubled about it, so He did what WE should do when we are troubled – He prayed! Spend time praying today. Go on a prayer walk around your neighbor hood or find a favorite spot in your house or yard and sit and pray for awhile



#### Day #5 Jesus and the Crowds (Matthew 14:1-21)

WOAH DID YOU KNOW: Jesus had 6 trials before his crucifixion.

- Picture it: Read the story and imagine what it might have been like to be at Jesus's trial or to have been there when He died. It was a sad time for many people who loved Jesus, BUT the story didn't end there. We celebrate the best part of the story on Easter Sunday – that Jesus is ALIVE!
- Answer it: Why did the guard make the grave secure?
   What were they afraid would happen?
- Live it Out: So now Jesus is in a tomb, the tomb is sealed, and the tomb is heavily guarded! Things seem impossible, don't they? But remember, NOTHING is impossible with God! Is there anything that you feel is impossible in your life today?
   Spend time praying about it! Then find a rock and decorate it with the verse Luke 1:37 as a reminder that nothing is impossible with God.
