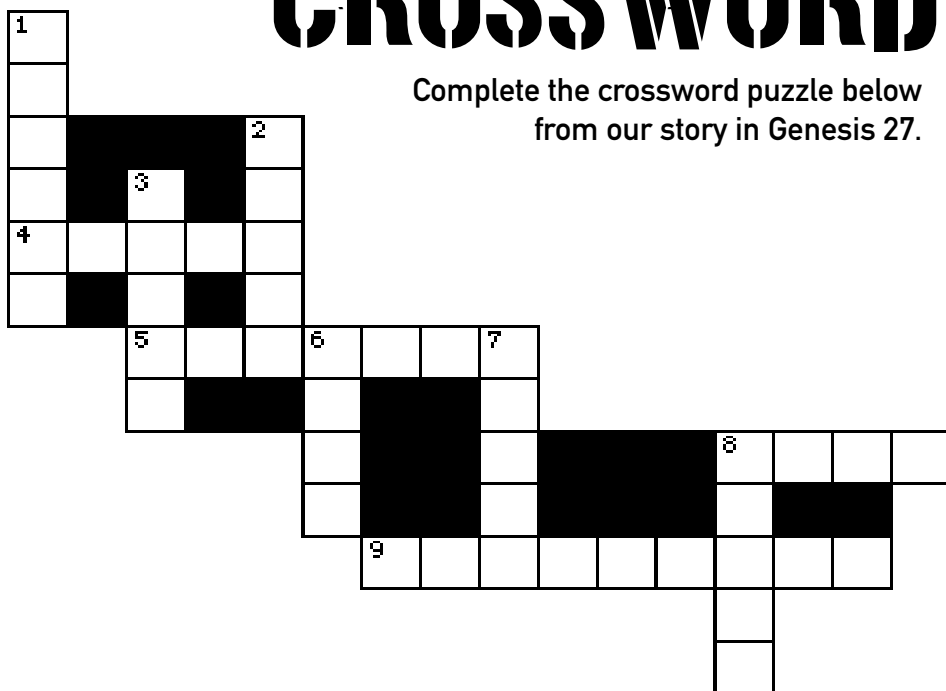

COVER THE QUARTER



One of the many bad things about lying is that you sometimes have to tell other lies to keep from getting caught in your first lie! AAAAAAAA! More lies! Here's a little game designed to help you see just how hard it can be to cover up a lie.

REMEMBER: Lies are harmful even if you DO cover them up!

YOU WILL NEED:



A BUCKET



1 QUARTER



6 PENNIES

INSTRUCTIONS

Fill a bucket halfway with water. Drop the quarter into the bucket. **THIS QUARTER IS THE LIE THAT YOU TOLD.** Split up the pennies between the players. Each penny represents another lie you tell to cover up the original lie. Each player gets to drop their pennies into the bucket attempting to cover the quarter.

After everyone has dropped their pennies, look at the original lie, the quarter. If you were not successful in covering the lie, then you got caught telling a lie, and got caught telling all the other lies. If you are successful in covering the original lie, then count how many lies it took to cover for one lie.



REMEMBER: Lies harm you even if you get away with them!
