The United States once tried to train cats to be spies. It was called **Operation Acoustic Kitty.**

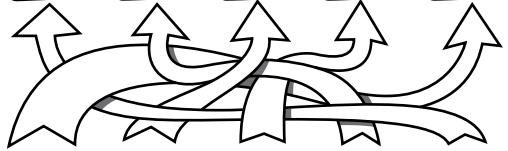

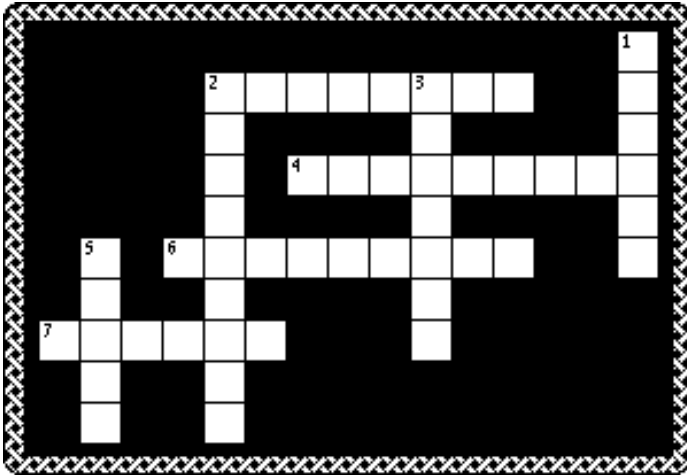

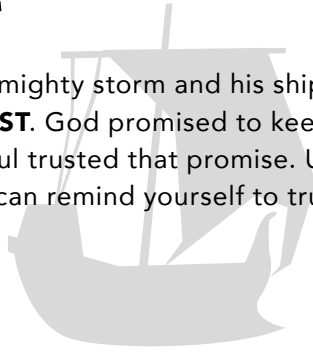


When has it been hard for you to trust God? Look up the following verses to remind you of God's promises and then highlight them in your Bible:
