MORNING TIME

As you help your child get dressed in the morning, place a mirror on a low table or stand in front of a full-length mirror and let your child look at him/herself. Talk with your child about what they see. Point out the color of their eyes, the color of their hair, and what makes them special. Remind them that God made them and they are special to God.



PLAY TIME

Grab some playdoh and cookie cutters and have fun creating playdoh people together. Make people who are tall and people who are short; people with long hair and short hair; see if you can make each person in your family. As you play together, remind your child that God made people and God made them. They are special to God!



PLAY TIME

Go to the "JWKids Nursery Playlist"

http://jacobswellchurch.church/jwkids and play the song "God made Me – WONDERFUL" by Amber Sky Records. As you listen to the song, grab a blanket or a bedsheet and use it to make a parachute. While the music is playing, bounce a pillow in the blanket, walk in a circle, make waves by shaking the blanket, or just have fun raising it high and low. As you play, remind your child that God made them and they are special to God.



OUTSIDE TIME

Use sidewalk chalk to trace an outline of your child on the sidewalk or driveway. Then let your toddler use the chalk to draw hair, a face, etc. As you draw, remind them that God made them and they are special to God.



CUDDLE TIME

Go to the "JWKids Nursery Playlist" http://jacobswellchurch.church/jwkids and watch this month's new story with Ms. Danielle called "God Made Me", OR grab your favorite kid's Bible or the Bible App for kids and read the creation story together. Remind your child that God made him/her and they are special to God.



BATH TIME

As you wash your child during bath time, say, "God made everything! God made you! God made your eyes. Where are your eyes? God made your nose. Where is your nose? God made your knees. Where are your knees? (Continue as long as they are interested: mouth, hands, feet, etc)
