MARK 4:35-41

Jesus can do anything! He calmed a storm when everyone else on the boat was afraid

WEEK 2

JOHN 6: 1-14

Jesus can do anything! He fed more than 5,000 people with just two fish and five small loaves of bread.
Ask: Would you have given your lunch to Jesus to share with everyone? Why?

WEEK 3

MARK 10: 46-52

Jesus can do anything! Jesus healed a man who was blind.
Ask: What did the blind man do when he found out Jesus was calling to him?

WEEK 4

JOHN 21: 1-13

Jesus can do anything! Jesus filled his disciples' net with fish after it had been empty (John 21: 1-13).
Ask: What's your favorite Bible story about Jesus' miracles?

THINGS TO DO



Grab a jump rope, some shoelaces, or a long string to play a fun game to help your child learn this month's bible verse! Lay the rope or shoelace in the middle of your living room. Then have your child walk across it, like walking on a tight rope. Each time they take a step, have them say one word of the bible verse, "Nothing is impossible with God." Switch it up by having them walk backwards or jump back and forth over the rope.



Using playdoh, you and your child can re-create the week's Bible story. You can make playdoh fish and loaves of bread, make a boat and giant waves, even make a face! Remind your child that "Jesus can do anything."
